


In the EU as a whole, 24.3 % of households included children, while 75.7 % did not.

Among EU Member States, more than 30 % of households had children in Slovakia (33.9%), Ireland (32.4 %), Cyprus (30.6 %), and Romania (30.3 %). On the other hand, 20 % or less of households in Germany (20.0 %) and Finland (18.1 %) included children.

Couples accounted for 63.5 % of households with children in the EU, making it the most common type of household with children. Sweden, Finland, Greece, the Netherlands, and Slovenia had the highest percentages of couples among households with children, over 70 %. Croatia, Bulgaria, Denmark, and Latvia had the lowest percentages, with less than 50 % of households with children being

#### Households by type and presence of children, 2022 (% of total households)




- Single adult without children

#### Households by presence and number of children, 2022 (% of total households)






